Introduction

The Mediterranean, despite occupying less than 1% of the world's oceanic surface, hosts 10% of known marine species, making it a true treasure trove of biodiversity. However, the limited size of this sea results in reduced water turnover, making it particularly sensitive to anthropogenic impacts such as pollution, climate change, and maritime traffic, progressively compromising its health.

The project is gaining an increasingly international dimension, also thanks to the scientific results produced, which represent a unique contribution to the world of research concerning the Mediterranean Sea basin.

Objectives

M.A.R.E. (Marine Adventure for Research & Education) is an initiative by Centro Velico Caprera Foundation, in collaboration with One Ocean Foundation, that brings together a series of partners united by their sensitivity to the protection of marine ecosystems in a research project aimed at monitoring the health of the Mediterranean Sea. The primary objectives of the project are:

- Dissemination: dissemination of knowledge and accessible testimony to a wider audience.
- Scientific Research: scientific analysis of marine environments thanks to the presence of biologists on board.
- Institutional sharing: meetings with national and international authorities to share a common charter on the best practices to adopt.
